From the Principal's Desk

It has been a big week at Berhampore School with the official launch of the new school values of We Care for Ourselves, Others and the Environment. A big thank you to the staff who put in a huge amount of effort and time preparing this event for the school to enjoy. Another huge thank you to the parents who came along and participated in the events. One thing whānau can do to support the roll out of these values is to discuss these values and their importance at home with your children. We will be sending home magnets with the values on them to aid this.

As you may have heard there was an incident involving a child being grabbed by a male on her way home from school last week. She was able to get away from him and run but it serves as a timely reminder to discuss with your children common sense actions to keep themselves safe. A good agreed plan with your child on safe travels to and from school are very important, including where to go and what to do if they are worried. The three A's are a helpful in discussing this; always travel with companions, always let your adults know where you are, always stick with the agreed way to get to and from school.

We are asking that whānau are actively thinking about safe behaviours around drop off time before school. This is a very busy time with a large amount of cars around. The Stanley Street drop off zone is the safest place to drop off your child at this time. Please ensure you plan your trip ahead of time to avoid needing to make 3-point turns on Stanley Street. It is best to approach the drop off zone from Britomart Street and depart via Chilka Street.

A mystery fancy bottle auction and spot prizes will add extra spice to the night, which will see Quiz Mistress Extraordinaire Sarah Millar in charge once again.

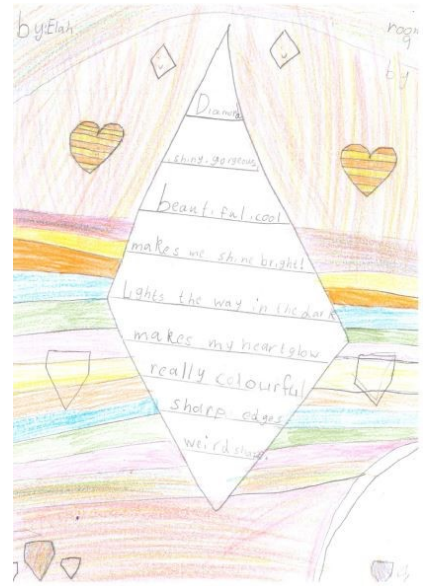
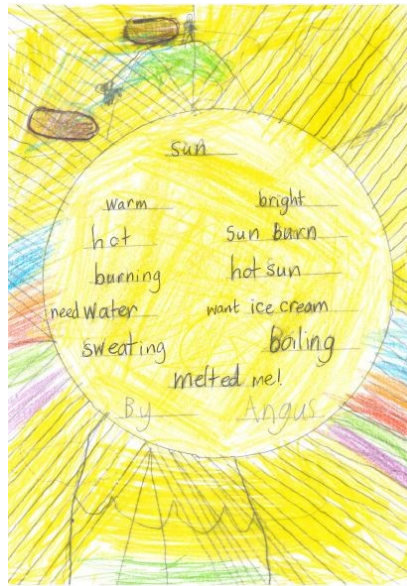
